



Meet Hatchery Manager,

Emma

At Rainbow Spring Nature Park, Emma helps to protect New Zealand's cherished national bird. With only 5% of Kiwis hatched in the wild surviving to adulthood and a steady population decline of 2-3% per year, conservation projects such as the National Kiwi Hatchery are needed to save the Kiwi bird.

Emma and her team hatch vulnerable Kiwi eggs, incubating them in a safe environment at the Rotorua facility. This eight-month process protects the eggs from predators and releases adults back into the forest where they were originally found. Support Rainbow Springs Nature Park with a guided tour of the hatchery, encounter these charming creatures and learn about the conservation efforts to save them.
