Day 1: Arrive Darwin (D)

Welcome to the iconic Top End! You will be met on arrival at Darwin airport and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy the unique character of the Northern Territories tropical capital city, before meeting your Evergreen Tours' Tour Director and travelling companions for a welcome reception and dinner. **Two Night Stay:** Doubletree by Hilton Esplanade.

Day 2: Darwin at Leisure (FB)

Discover More: Visit Litchfield National Park or travel to Adelaide River and see the famed jumping saltwater crocs. Alternatively, enjoy a sunset cruise on Darwin Harbour, take the hop-on-hop-off bus tour or the WWII Bombing of Darwin Tour (must be pre-booked, own expense).

Day 3: Kakadu National Park – Yellow Water Cruise (FB,D)

Enter the amazing World Heritage listed Kakadu National Park which is renowned for its natural beauty. Visit Nourlangie Rock which exhibits some of the oldest Aboriginal rock art in the world, dating back 50,000 years. Stop at the

Bowali Visitor Centre, learn about the local region's rich culture and wildlife, before a cruise on the Yellow Water Billabong. **Overnight Stay:** Kakadu Crocodile Hotel.

Day 4: Nitmiluk National Park – Katherine Gorge Cruise (FB,D)

Discover More: Take a spectacular flight over Kakadu (must be pre-booked, own expense). Travel to Nitmiluk National Park and enjoy a guided cruise through the spectacular Katherine Gorge. Marvel at the towering sandstone walls as your guide points out ancient Aboriginal rock art and unique wildlife. **Overnight Stay:** Ibis Styles Katherine (or similar).

Day 5: Lake Argyle– Ord River Cruise – Kununurra (FB,D)

Experience the true vastness of this outback land as you cross the border into Western Australia and journey into the Carr Boyd Ranges before arriving at magnificent Lake Argyle, the largest lake in the Southern Hemisphere. One of the highlights of the journey is a magnificent cruise on the Ord River where you will pass beneath immense gorge walls, view

peaceful river scenery and spot some of the region's abundant wildlife. Enjoy the sunset as you arrive into Kununurra. **Two Night Stay:** Hotel Kununurra.

Day 6: Kununurra (FB)

Discover More: Take a flight over the incredible Bungle Bungles Range (must be pre-booked, own expense). Visit the magical Hidden Valley National Park, known as the mini Bungle Bungles with unusual and colourful sandstone formations. **You're Invited:** Visit the Hoochery Distillery for a tasting of the local rum – Western Australia's oldest continuously operating still.

Day 7: Hidden Valley – El Questro (FB,D)

Follow the Cockburn Range to the acclaimed El Questro Wilderness Park, a million-acre park set in stunning outback Kimberley landscape. Enjoy a spectacular cruise through Chamberlain Gorge, a fresh waterhole bound by diverse flora and fauna set beneath towering 60m tall sheer walled cliffs. Continue through the stunning untamed Kimberley landscape to the unique Emma Gorge Resort. **Overnight Stay:** Emma Gorge Resort.

Day 8: El Questro – Argyle Diamond Mine – Halls Creek (FB,L,D)

Travel to the world's single largest producer of diamonds, the Argyle Diamond Mine, for a private guided tour of the open cut mine. Continue on to Halls Creek, the oasis of the Kimberley and once the hub of a gold rush in the late 1800's. **Overnight Stay:** Halls Creek Motel.

Day 9: Geikie Gorge Cruise – Derby (FB,D)

Continue to the Fitzroy River and cruise the exquisite Geikie Gorge with its unusual white banded walls. Keep your eye out for local wildlife including sawfish, stingrays and freshwater crocodiles. **Overnight Stay:** Spinifex Lodge Derby.

Day 10: Derby – Broome (FB)

Travel to the famous town of Broome surrounded by a pristine coastline. Broome was originally founded as a pearling port over a hundred years ago and now boasts


